enhance	<i>verb</i>	to improve the quality, amount, or strength of something <i>Speak English Today hopes to enhance learner's English skills.</i>
relatable	<i>adjective</i>	that someone can understand or to relate to something else <i>This casual podcast is meant to be relatable to the audience.</i>
get to someone	<i>phrasal verb</i>	to cause feelings, especially of suffering or disgust, in someone <i>The heat was beginning to get to me, so I went indoors.</i>
struggle	<i>verb; noun</i>	to proceed with difficulty or with great effort; a huge effort <i>We all struggle to learn a new language.</i>
bilingual	<i>adjective, noun</i>	able to use two languages equally well; <i>Most Indonesians are bilinguals.</i>
take a chance	<i>idiom</i>	to do something that could have either good or bad results <i>It might not work, but we'll have to take the chance.</i>
articulate	<i>adjective</i>	showing the quality of being clear and easily understood <i>It's important to be articulate when speaking to a foreigner.</i>
a no-brainer	<i>noun; informal</i>	something that is very simple to do or to understand <i>The topics of this podcast are a no-brainer.</i>
