Vocabulary of the week

ditch	<i>verb; informal</i>	to get rid or to give up something <i>I'm so ditching my girlfriend because she cheated on me.</i>
cheat on someone	<i>phrasal verb</i>	to secretly be with someone other than your husband, wife, etc. <i>He discovered she had been cheating on him.</i>
fancy	<i>verb; informal</i>	(UK) to want to have or to do something <i>I don't fancy being in a long-distance relationship.</i>
consideration	<i>noun</i>	the act of thinking about something carefully <i>After some consideration, we decided to go our separate ways.</i>
on the market	<i>idiom</i>	available (for purchase) <i>Gio's single and is on the market for a relationship.</i>
rock-solid	<i>adjective</i>	not likely to move or break <i>Our relationship is rock-solid, and we'll be together forever.</i>
make the most of something	<i>expression</i>	to show or use to the best advantage <i>We make the most of the time we have together.</i>
unintentionally	<i>adverb</i>	in a way that is not planned or to have purpose <i>Our feelings for each other started unintentionally.</i>
at stake	<i>expression</i>	at risk; at issue or in question <i>Going long-distance can really put our relationship at stake.</i>
