augment	<i>verb</i>	to enhance or to add something <i>He would have to find work to augment his income.</i>
inevitable	<i>adjective</i>	certain to happen and unable to be avoided or prevented <i>The progress of technology is inevitable.</i>
outdated	<i>adjective</i>	old-fashioned; not as good as something modern <i>My laptop is old and outdated. It's time to buy a new one.</i>
level up	<i>phrasal verb</i>	to go to a higher level or to a higher standard <i>Technology can certainly level up your quality of life.</i>
reach out to	<i>phrasal verb</i>	to make an effort to do something for other people <i>Companies reach out to local communities through CSR.</i>
late bloomer	<i>noun</i>	someone whose talents develop much later than most people <i>She was a late bloomer, but now is a famous programmer.</i>
quick-fire	<i>adjective</i>	happening very quickly, one after another <i>The quick-fire quiz was really stressful.</i>
